


54% of Africans back Trump but many are now prioritizing Africa's interests



While support for Trump remains strong in parts of the continent, a growing shift toward self-reliance and regional alliances is reshaping Africa's global strategy



Ghana (34%)
 Approve Trump's performance, 44% remain neutral on the matter. 60% support the "Africa First" approach.

Ivory Coast (64%)
 Approve Trump's performance, with 30% supporting the shift of focus to other global partners

Nigeria (72%)
 Approve Trump's performance. 39% support the "Africa First" approach.

Cameroon (57%)
 Approve Trump's performance, with 51% supporting the "Africa First" approach.

Kenya (49%)
 Approve Trump's performance, with 40% supporting the "Africa First" approach while 33% are for each country to be independent

Tanzania (45%)
 Approve Trump's performance, 41% are on the fence. 27% supporting the shift of focus to other global partners

South Africa (57%)
 Approve Trump's performance. 49% support the "Africa First" approach.
